Sheriff's Department Update

- Jacob Morrison presented a quote for jail door replacements.
- Jerry Sedlacek moved to approve \$4,427 for two doors to be installed by Shepard Farm & Construction out of Courthouse General. Kevin Stuber 2nd, motion passed.
- Jacob Morrison reported five department vehicles have issues and there are no spare vehicles available. He also requested to replace the jail refrigerator.

Facility Equipment Discussion

Solid Waste Update

- David Waddell reported that the 14 loads of trees from the nursing home demolition are being burned.
- The transfer station has only one roll-off container left to rent, he would like to look into purchasing a few more to expand the service.
- He is testing a service requested for Prime Meats to pick up twice per week in order to determine cost.
