

Resolution No. 25-15

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY OF WOODSON, KANSAS TO LEVY A PROPERTY TAX RATE EXCEEDING THE REVENUE NEUTRAL RATE;

WHEREAS, the Revenue Neutral Rate for the County of Woodson was calculated as 94.776 mills by the Woodson County Clerk; and

WHEREAS, the budget proposed by the Governing Body of the County of Woodson will require the levy of a property tax rate exceeding the Revenue Neutral Rate; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body held a hearing on September 16, 2025 allowing all interested taxpayers desiring to be heard an opportunity to give oral testimony; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the County of Woodson, having heard testimony, still finds it necessary to exceed the Revenue Neutral Rate.

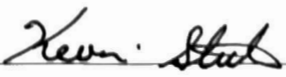
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE COUNTY OF WOODSON:

The County of Woodson shall levy a property tax rate exceeding the Revenue Neutral Rate of 104.256 mills.

This resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and shall remain in effect until future action is taken by the Governing Body.

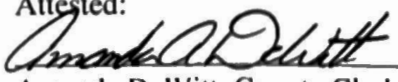
