## RESOLUTION NO. R-25-16

A RESOLUTION FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF MODIFICATIONS TO THE SIGNAGE AND SPEED LIMITS ON CERTAIN PORTIONS OF WOODSON COUNTY ROADS UNDER COUNTY CONTROL, ALL IN WOODSON COUNTY, KANSAS.

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the Board of County Commissioners of WOODSON County, Kansas that, in the interest of public safety it is prudent to modify the existing signage, at the intersections of Kanza Road and 110<sup>th</sup> Road and 130<sup>th</sup> Road and reducing the speed limits on 110<sup>th</sup> Road and Kanza Road which are under County control and located in Woodson County, Kansas.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WOODSON COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Stop signs will be placed at the intersection of Kanza Road and 110<sup>th</sup>
Road directing all north and south bound traffic on Kanza Road to stop at said intersection.

Stop signs will be placed at the intersection of Kanza Road and 130<sup>th</sup> Road directing all north and south bound traffic on Kanza Road to stop at said intersection.

**SECTION 2**. The speed limit on 110<sup>th</sup> Road from US Highway 54 to Kanza Road will be reduced to 35 miles per hour.

The speed limit on Kanza Road from 110<sup>th</sup> Road to 130<sup>th</sup> Road will be reduced to 35 miles per hour.

- SECTION 3. The Woodson County Road and Bridge Department, or its designee as determined by the Woodson County Road and Bridge Director, shall erect appropriate signage to facilitate the changes set forth above.
- SECTION 4. The aforementioned signage shall be erected and placed in accordance with Kansas law.
- SECTION 5. This Resolution shall take effect upon publication in the official county newspaper.
