

**RESOLUTION NO. 26- 04**

**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE OPERATING PLAN AND CLOSURE PLAN FOR THE WOODSON COUNTY, KANSAS MUNICIPAL SOLID WASTE TRANSFER STATION**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners of Woodson County, Kansas, has determined the need for safe, efficient, and regulatory-compliant management of solid waste within the county; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Kansas law, particularly K.S.A. 65-3401 et seq. and K.A.R. 28-29-23a, the County is responsible for the Operation of its Solid Waste Transfer Station and must maintain an approved Operating Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the Woodson County Solid Waste Director/Transfer Station Supervisor has developed an Operating Plan and Closure Plan for the Transfer Station and it has been submitted to and approved by the Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE) on January 15, 2026; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners has reviewed said Operating Plan and finds it to be in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Woodson County, Kansas.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WOODSON COUNTY, KANSAS:**

The Woodson County Transfer Station Operating Plan and Closure Plan, dated January 15, 2026, is hereby adopted in its entirety and incorporated herein by reference. The Solid Waste Director/Transfer Station Supervisor and County staff are directed to implement and abide by the provisions contained in said plan. The approved Operating Plan shall be available at the transfer station for inspection at all times as required by K.A.R. 28-29-23a. All prior resolutions or policies in conflict with this Operating Plan are hereby repealed.
