

WOODSON COUNTY RESOLUTION NO 26-07

A RESOLUTION CREATING AN EQUIPMENT FUND FOR THE USE OF THE SOLID WASTE DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, on this 10th day of March, 2026, at a duly assembled meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Woodson County, Kansas it has been determined that there is sufficient need for the Solid Waste Department to have a fund to accumulate monies to be used for the purpose of purchasing equipment for the Transfer Station.

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 19-2661 allows the Board of County Commissioners to establish fees and charges for the use of the Transfer Station Facility to produce revenue sufficient to operate the facility and for the maintenance and improvements of and related to such facility.

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 19-119 allows for the creation of a county equipment reserve fund for the purpose of financing the acquisition of equipment.

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 19-119 states this fund shall be funded by annually budgeted transfers from funds that obtain money from use charges.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT Resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Woodson County, Kansas, the creation of Fund 187 – Equipment Reserve Solid Waste to be funded with transfers from Fund 405 – Solid Waste at the end of each year from leftover budget funds.
