

RESOLUTION NO. 11-09
WOODSON COUNTY, KANSAS

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE USE OF A STOP SIGN AT THE INTERSECTIONS OF ELK AND 50TH RD ON THE NORTH AND SOUTHBOUND TRAFFIC IN WOODSON COUNTY, KANSAS.

WHEREAS, Woodson County has Home Rule and statutory authority to erect and maintain stop signs under K.S.A. 19-101a and K.S.A. 8-2008; and

WHEREAS, the County Commissioners of Woodson County, Kansas have considered erecting a stop sign to replace the yield sign located at the intersections of Elk and 50th Rd as set out below; and

WHEREAS, upon due consideration, the County Commissioners have determined that the erection of the stop sign described below will enhance public safety.


NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Woodson County, Kansas that the yield sign at the intersections of Elk and 50th Roads in Woodson County, Ks be replaced with stop signs for the north and southbound traveling traffic.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the yield signs shall be removed by Woodson County Road and Bridge Department and the stop signs shall be put in place by the Woodson County Road and Bridge Department.


This resolution shall become effective upon publication in the official county newspaper and posting of said signs.


