

Woodson County Resolution #16-04

A RESOLUTION CONCERNING THE SALARY AND COMPENSATION OF EMPLOYEES AND OFFICERS OF WOODSON COUNTY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WOODSON COUNTY, KANSAS that by a majority vote of the Board of the County Commissioners sitting in regular session on the 29th of November, 2016 adopt the following provision concerning compensation and salary of employees and officers of Woodson County, Kansas, to-wit:

1. That all full-time and regular part time salaried employees and elected officials shall receive a salary cost of living adjustment increase of \$43.34 per month effective the January 20th 2017 payroll.
2. Any Department head wishing to waive their cost of living adjustment and distribute it to an employee(s) within their department may do so at their discretion. However, the amount distributed must not exceed the amount stated above.
3. That all full time employees and elected officials not on probation shall receive a salary cost of living adjustment increase of \$.25 per hour and all regular part time hourly employees not on probation shall receive a salary cost of living adjustment increase to be pro-rated per hour effective the January 20th 2017 payroll.
4. That should the Board of County Commissioners of Woodson County wish to readopt the provision provided for herein for subsequent years that they may do so by passing a motion readopting this resolution rather than adopting a similar resolution in subsequent years.
5. This resolution shall take effect upon publication one (1) time in the Yates Center News.




