RESOLUTION NO. 98-10  
AND AGREEMENT

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING "WOODSON" COUNTY TO JOIN WITH AND PARTICIPATE IN THE THIRTY-FIRST JUDICIAL DISTRICT JUVENILE JUSTICE AUTHORITY AND AGREEMENT TO COOPERATE.

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 75-7001 et seq., commonly known as "JUVENILE JUSTICE AUTHORITY ACT" provides that the Commissioner of Juvenile Justice may make grants to counties for the development, implementation, operation and improvement of Juvenile Correctional services; and

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 75-7039 et seq. provides that a group of counties may cooperate together to establish a juvenile corrections advisory board and to adopt a comprehensive plan for the development, implementation and operation of juvenile corrections subject to approval by the Commissioner of Juvenile Justice and which provides for the centralized administration and control of juvenile correctional services; and

WHEREAS, The Judges of the Thirty-First Judicial Districts have recommended the four counties contained within their judicial district; to-wit: Allen, Neosho, Wilson and Woodson Counties, enter into an inter-local agreement establishing a multi-county juvenile corrections program and establish a juvenile corrections advisory board; and

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Woodson County determine it to be in the best interest of the county to support and join with the Thirty-First Judicial District in its endeavor to develop and implement a multi-county juvenile corrections program in the Thirty- First Judicial District; and

WHEREAS, Residents of this county have participated in meetings and have joined in the operation of the Thirty-First Judicial District Juvenile Justice Authority planning team and recommend the establishment of the Thirty-First Judicial District Juvenile Corrections Advisory Board as the Administrative body to receive grants under the Justice Authority Act and act as agent for the four counties in retaining an authority for the expenditures of monies, including grants received, and for the implementation of and the operations under the comprehensive plan approved by the Commissioner of Juvenile Justice.

WHEREAS, The county has agreed, pursuant to K.S.A. 12-2904, to enter into a contract with other counties in the Thirty-First Judicial District who shall execute similar agreements for the following:

1. To establish a Thirty-First Judicial District Juvenile Corrections Advisory Board which Board shall act as the administrative body pursuant to K.S.A. 75-7042 and shall have the powers enumerated in K.S.A. 75-7042, to:

- (a) Acquire by any lawful means, including purchase, lease or transfer of custodial control the lands, buildings and equipment necessary and incidental to such purposes;
- (b) enter into contracts, which are necessary and incidental to such purposes;
- (c) determine and establish the administrative structure best suited to the efficient administration and delivery of such correctional services;
- (d) employ a director and such other officers, employees, and agents as deemed necessary to carry out the provisions of this act;
- (e) make grants in accordance with the comprehensive plan of funds provided by grant payments under K.S.A. 75-7050 and amendments thereto to corporations organized not for profit, for development, operation and improvement of such correctional service; and
- (f) use unexpended funds, accept gifts, grants and subsidies from any lawful source, and apply for, accept and expend federal funds.

2. To acquire, hold and dispose of any real and/or personal property used in the implementation of the juvenile correctional services under this plan as prescribed by law.

3. This agreement shall begin and continue so long as there is state funding available and granted for juvenile correctional services, as deemed sufficient by the Thirty-First District Juvenile Justice Authority Comprehensive Plan.

4. Upon written notice to other counties and the Board, any county may withdraw from this agreement, effective at the conclusion of any state fiscal year, as long as any withdrawing county satisfies its legal responsibilities pursuant to K.S.A. 75-5290 et seq.

WHEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AND AGREED THAT: The Board of County Commissioners of Woodson County shall participate in the Juvenile Justice Authority Corrections Act by participating in the four county plan, known as the Thirty-First Judicial District Juvenile Justice Authority comprised of the Thirty-First Judicial District, and utilize the Thirty-First Judicial District Juvenile Justice Authority Comprehensive Plan to implement the juvenile corrections program, as mandated by K.S.A. 75-7038 et seq.

This Board further resolves and agrees to authorize \_\_\_\_\_ County to act as the administrating county to receive and administer all grant monies for juvenile corrections purposes.
