

RESOLUTION NO. R-24-12

A RESOLUTION FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF MODIFICATIONS TO THE SIGNAGE ON CERTAIN PORTIONS OF WOODSON COUNTY ROADS UNDER COUNTY CONTROL, ALL IN WOODSON COUNTY, KANSAS.

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the Board of County Commissioners of WOODSON County, Kansas that, in the interest of public safety it is prudent to modify the existing signage, specifically the stop signs, located at the intersection of 110<sup>th</sup> Road and Jay Road which are under County control and located in Woodson County, Kansas.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WOODSON COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The stop sign currently placed on east bound 110<sup>th</sup> Road at the intersection with Jay Road shall be removed.

A stop sign shall be placed on the north side of the intersection of 110<sup>th</sup> and Jay Road so that south bound traffic on Jay Road shall be required to stop.

SECTION 2. The Woodson County Road and Bridge Department, or its designee as determined by the Woodson County Road and Bridge Director, shall erect appropriate signage as set forth above.

SECTION 3. The aforementioned signage shall be erected and placed in accordance with Kansas law.


SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect upon publication in the official county newspaper.
