A RESOLUTION FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF MODIFICATIONS TO THE SIGNAGE ON CERTAIN PORTIONS OF WOODSON COUNTY ROADS UNDER COUNTY CONTROL, ALL IN WOODSON COUNTY, KANSAS.

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the Board of County Commissioners of WOODSON County, Kansas that, in the interest of public safety it is prudent to modify the existing signage located at the intersection of 100th Road and Coyote Road which are under County control and located in Woodson County, Kansas.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WOODSON COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The yield signs currently placed on 100th Road at the intersection with Coyote Road shall be replaced with stop signs.

A yield sign shall be placed on the "Y" intersection going northwest from 100th Road to Coyote Road indicating traffic utilizing the "Y" intersection shall yield to traffic on Coyote Road.

SECTION 2. The Woodson County Road and Bridge Department, or its designee as determined by the Woodson County Road and Bridge Director, shall erect appropriate signage as set forth above.


SECTION 3. The aforementioned signage shall be erected and placed in accordance with Kansas law.
